The Forest Society of Maine (FSM) is deeply grateful to Woodland Pulp and other businesses who support our forestland conservation work. Business support highlights the strong connection between forest conservation easements that keep forests as forests, and economic opportunities that arise from Maine's forest resources. FSM is doing well thanks to friends like you and as a token of our appreciation we recently placed an ad in the Bangor Daily News thanking you. A copy of this ad is enclosed.

This past year the pandemic required some changes to usual activities for many of us. Yet, FSM was able to approve a new strategic plan, renew our national land trust accreditation, reach annual goals, and conduct stewardship on 40 easements covering about one million acres. In the coming year we will be moving forward with fundraising for the Coburn Gore and Grafton Forest projects, doing baseline work for the Fish River Conservation Easement, and assisting landowners who continue to approach us about possible new projects.
